Please be respectful of hotel property and staff. We don't want anything broken, and we're sure you don't want to be responsible for something being broken. Just keep in mind that we're all guests at the hotel, and we want to keep coming back!

Only use painter's tape to hang posters and other things around the convention. Anything else will be taken down by a member of AF staff. Again, we don't want to damage the hotel!

Please note that curfew hours for the city of Fargo are between 11pm and 6am. Any persons under age 16 are not allowed to be in a public space without a parent or guardian during this time, including the public spaces of the hotel.

Cosplay & Weapons Policy

Anime Fargo staff members have the final say on whether something is appropriate.

If it's illegal outside the con, it's illegal inside the con.

Anime Fargo reserves the right to change our policies at any time. That being said, we want all congoers to have fun and be able to proudly • display their costumes!

For the purposes of this policy, a "costume" includes clothing, accessories, props, etc.

- Badges must be visible at all times, regardless of your costume/dress. Please display your badge somewhere on your torso (between neck and waist).
- Shoes must be worn at all times. Socks and bare feet are not permitted.
- Costumes must be cover areas commonly covered by a standard swimsuit and be in compliance with public decency laws and regulations.
- Remember, this is a family-friendly convention, and there will be children present. Profane language or symbols as part of a costume or printed on normal clothing will not be tolerated.
- Be tasteful with regards to clothing that may be offensive in any way.
- Cosplayers are asked to be mindful of the radius of their costumes and props. Some cosplays can be large and elaborate.
 However, please be courteous to your fellow con-goers. If your costume is interfering with others' movement, you may be asked to remove or change a portion.

- Any weapon props must be visibly peace bound.
- Live steel is permissible, but it must be peace bonded into the sheath. If there is no way to bind it into the sheath it is NOT permitted.
- Peace-bound bladed weapons CANNOT come out of their sheath at any time during the convention for any reason.
- Projectile weapons must be unfireable.
 How this is accomplished is up to the
 attendee. Some actions that will achieve
 this goal may include removing the firing
 mechanism, removing the firing pin, or
 making the slide/magazine load nonfunctioning. All projectile weapons will be
 peace bonded with a zip tie in such a
 fashion that the trigger cannot be pulled,
 as an added safety measure.
- No projectiles are allowed. This includes operating airsoft guns, filled water guns, and NERF gun darts.
- All non-steel and non-projectile weapons or props must be peace tied. This will be done with a temporary marking in a visible location on the prop that indicates that your prop has been approved by safety to be in the convention space.
- Consequences for removing a peace tie/peace bond will be determined depending on the type of weapon or prop, any actions involving the prop/weapon in question, and whether you have been previously approached.
- Consequences are at the discretion of convention staff and chairs. All decisions made will be non-negotiable and final.

Anyone deemed to violate these policies may be asked to change or leave the convention.

Anime Fargo fully believes that **COSPLAY IS NOT CONSENT.**Please be respectful of your fellow congoers.


If you pre-registered, your badge is ready for you at the registration desk. Please provide the Eventeny QR code or confirmation number to pick up your badge.

Anime Fargo is proud to support River Keepers of Fargo-Moorhead as our 2025 charity.

River Keepers grew from a desire to rediscover the Red River's heritage, and to teach people to again appreciate the "Red" as a living River.

In earlier decades of Fargo-Moorhead history, people used and appreciated the Red River for a variety of activities. In later years, people lost that appreciation for the river, which is the dominant geographical feature in the community, and began to consider it a liability to be avoided.

River Keepers was established in 1990 after a large community-wide assessment said that the Red River is underutilized, underappreciated and—in some cases—mistreated. We coordinate efforts in conservation, safety, recreation, riparian restoration and water quality among local agencies in the Fargo, North Dakota/Moorhead, Minnesota region. We create programs and events for current and future leaders designed to build a sound foundation for science-based decision making.

We have made significant progress in helping the community understand the value and importance of the Red River. Our education and advocacy programs have been recognized by numerous organizations and agencies, including the EPA, which awarded us the "Friend of the EPA", the Clay County Soil & Water Conservation District, which awarded us "2018 Outstanding Conservationist", and the City of Moorhead awarded us their Moorheart Award in 2022.

Thistle Witch (they/he) is a cosplayer from Minneapolis, Minnesota. They started cosplaying and watching anime as a way to connect with and engage students in online learning over the pandemic. Since then they have fallen in love with the costume making, and connecting through performance.

Besides education, and cosplay, their other passion is LGBTQIA+ awareness. Trans rights and gay themes are often part of their skits. In 2024 Thistle Witch opened a trans-owned and run electrolysis clinic for trans people in Minneapolis, Trans Health Collective.

Briana is the Senior Features Editor for Crunchyroll. Here, she works with an amazing team that puts up with her emotions about SK8 the Infinity and whatever sports anime is airing that season. Outside of that, she's an author with a number of releases. There's her middle–grade book series, In Search of Superpowers: A Fantasy Pin World Adventure, about a group of kids who get superpowered enamel pins. There's The Essential Manga Guide: 50 Series Every Manga Fan Should Know, an essay guide where she rambles on about why manga is a vital part of our reading experience. And there's her magical girl series magnifiqueNOIR, her love letter to Sailor Moon in the form of black, queer magical girls.

Meanwhile, you may have heard stories from Snow's horror anthology Little Creepers on podcasts like Ghoul Intentions and the always spine-tingling Mr. Creepy Pasta. Her latest book is Uncertain Aspects, an urban fantasy mystery series where certain individuals affect those around them in unexpected ways. She also runs the blog Well, Are They?, a review site that covers queer media and is home to the couple's Queer Manga Book Club. When she's not writing, you can catch her (potentially swearing) at her sewing machine as she designs variations of her and Briana's favorite characters. She does this through both cosplay and everyday looks that show off her love of all things geeky and creative.

When going to conventions, Briana and Snow always bring their best. You can get lost in their books or their ongoing conversations about anime, ships, and video games. 



Convention Map




